Portland Ondo was a grassroots effort by members of the Oregon Buddhist Temple 2016 to create a bon odori for Portland. The members formed committees who created the music, wrote the lyrics, and did the orchestration of the final piece. Sahomi Tachibana, a Japanese classical dancer, teacher, and our bon odori sensei, choreographed a dance that depicted the mountains, rivers, and drawbridges of Portland, Oregon. Portland Ondo was premiered at the 2016 Obon Fest with vocalists and instrumentalists from the temple.

A recording was made in June 2018, and features Jenna Yokoyama and Enshane Hill-Nomoto on vocals; Traci Kiyama and Elaine Yuzuriha on fue; Wynn Kiyama on percussion; and Reverend Yuki Sugahara on electric bass.
